Tobyhanna General Ordnance Depot 1919 Ammunition Storage Magazines

One hundred years ago, one of the uses of the former Tobyhanna Military Reservation, was to temporarily store huge quantities of ammunition and other high explosives coming back to the United States following the end of World War I. These explosives were stored in 20' by 60' buildings spaced 1000 feet apart. All that remains of these sixty storage buildings are stone foundations scattered around State Game Lands #127, between Tobyhanna and Pocono Pines.

Bill Leonard and Bob McHale will give a presentation about the early days of military activity at Tobyhanna, with the establishment of the Tobyhanna General Ordnance Depot, and will show maps and photographs of all that remains of this extensive, although short-lived, activity on the reservation in 1919.
