Regulations

- ❖ There is no fee for participation.
- ❖ Artwork must be exhibition ready. Work should be appropriately matted, framed, and wired for hanging.
- ❖ Size is limited to 36" in width and 36" in height. (Including frame)
- ❖ If submitting a sculpture or craft that requires a pedestal or special hanger, the artist must provide it at the delivery of the work.
- ❖ Sculpture size is limited to 36" in all directions. (Not including pedestal)
- ❖ Works created by Coolbaugh Township residents may depict any family friendly subject matter. Works created by non-residents should depict family friendly subject matter related to Coolbaugh Township.
- ❖ Artist registration and release form must be filled out and signed.
- ❖ Artists are responsible for insuring their work during the exhibition.
- ❖ Either the artist or a friend must deliver the works in person on Sunday August 18th between 12:00 and 3:00 p.m. to the Bicentennial Museum.
- ❖ Works must be picked up Sunday September 1st between 2:00 and 4:00 p.m. Works not picked up at this time will be subjected to a \$5 handling fee. CTHA is not responsible for unclaimed works.
- ❖ Works may be offered for sale. CTHA requires a 20% commission on works sold. If you do not wish to sell your work, print NFS in the price category. For information on purchasing artwork please contact CTHA at 894-4207 and ask to speak with either Mary Barlieb or Kay Kinsley

Definitions of the Categories for Awards

Acrylic: Any 2-dimensional artwork created by applying acrylic paint to a surface, such as canvas, paper, or board.

Student: Artwork can be in any of the listed categories. Students in the K-6 can be entering Kindergarten and have not yet attended 7th grade.

The 7-12 category refers to any student who has completed 6th grade but has not yet completed 12th grade.

Digital Art: Artwork created through computer application, including photographs altered through a computer application.

Collage & Mixed Media: Artwork that is displayed on the wall, and is created by attaching a variety of papers, textures, materials, and or objects to a surface. This can also refer to a mixing of a variety of paints and other 2 dimensional media.

Sculpture: Any 3-dimensional artwork that is free standing and/ or relief (Projects dimensionally from a surface).

Fiber Arts: Artwork created by weaving, sewing, stitching, felting, or any other material in the soft or fabric art genre.

Photography: Must be original direct observation photographs. Photographs altered through computer programs will be judged in the digital art category.

Oil: Any 2-dimensional artwork created through applying oil based media onto a surface with brush or other art making tool.

Drawing: Any 2-dimensional art created by applying graphite, colored pencils, pen and ink, marker, and/or charcoal to paper. The drawing category is open to all types, including direct observation of nature, figure or object drawing, cartoon, illustration, and abstract drawing.

Watercolor: Any 2-dimensional painting genre that refers to applying a liquid watercolor paint to paper with a brush.

** Clarification: Drawing and Watercolor, while both traditionally works on paper, will be judged as separate individual categories.*
